Nov. 29, 2015 *The Journey: Mary*

MONDAY:

SCRIPTURE: Luke 1:26-38: Write down one verse or phrase that speaks to you today.

OBSERVATION: Write down all the objectives used to describe Mary in this passage?

APPLICATION: Have you ever heard God calling you to do something that you thought would be impossible to carry out? If so, what was it?

PRAYER: God, help me to listen when you call me and give me the strength to do the impossible.

TUESDAY:

SCRIPTURE: Read Isaiah 11:1-6: Write down one verse or phrase that speaks to you today.

OBSERVATION: The word Nazareth may come from the Hebrew word *netzer*, which means “branch” or “shoot.” Jesus’ hometown and the place Mary grew up was Nazareth. What do you think the gospel writers want us to see by reminding us that Mary is from Nazareth?

APPLICATION: Isaiah 11:1-6 is a promise of hope. How does this passage give you hope today?

PRAYER: God of Hope, thank you for the promise that even though this world seems out of control, you are in control and will bring peace.
